In light of the shortage of reloading supplies we will be offering a **“Wild West”** Category at Tusco. This is basically an Open Class. Any Guns, Any Style, Any Age. Any SASS Legal Guns and Ammo can be used, including .22 Caliber. This is being offered as an alternative to not shooting at all if someone can't find reloading supplies.

## **Six Stages**

Starting in April we will be shooting six stages. A few people have told us that they drive a good distance to shoot at Tusco and would like to shoot as much as possible. Obviously we only have room for five shooting bays. So what we are going to do is shoot the first stage you start on twice. Consider it a warm up stage. Only five stages will be scored. You can take your best time on your first stage. If you don't want to shoot it twice you do not have to. This would provide more shooting for our shooters.

# Prairie Dawg's Little-Known Facts of Western History

## Two Famous Gunfights of the Old West



Luke Short vs. Longhair Jim Courtwright

Timothy Isaiah Courtwright, also known as "Longhair Jim" or "Big Jim" Courtwright was an American lawman, outlaw and gunfighter.

In 1876, he became the first elected marshal of Fort Worth and had to keep peace in the notorious Hells Half Acre section, the town's wild red-light district. At that time, Fort Worth was a very dangerous place, with altercations between unruly drunks and lawmen being commonplace.

Luke Short was a gunfighter, gambler and bar owner who had drifted down to Fort Worth from Dodge City, Kansas. In Fort Worth, he managed the White Elephant, a saloon/gambling house.

Most gunfights took place at extreme close range, and this one is typical. Both men were gunfighters, and quarreled over Courtwright's protection racket. They fought almost at arm's length. Short fired first, cutting off Courtwright's thumb. Courtwright, unable to cock his pistol, reacted with extraordinary coolness, throwing his gun to his other hand in what was known as "the border shift." It didn't help. Short shot again and killed him.

The Wild Bill Hickok – Davis Tutt shootout was a gunfight which occurred on July 21, 1865 in the town square of Springfield, Missouri between Wild Bill Hickok, and cowboy, Davis Tutt.

It is one of the few recorded instances in the Old West of a one-on-one pistol quick-draw duel in a public place, in the manner later made iconic by countless dime novels, radio operas, and Western films.



The first story of the shootout was detailed in an article in Harper's Magazine in 1867, making Hickok a household name and folk hero.

Dave Tutt, a gambler, won James Butler Hickok's watch in a card game. Hickok, a poor loser, said that if Tutt so much as looked at the watch he would kill him. Tutt ignored the warning.

The gunfight took place in the town square at a distance of 75 yards. Tutt lost his nerve, drew first, and fired wildly. Hickok, who was a genuinely skilled shot, drew, took careful aim (some versions have him using a fencepost as a rest), and drilled Tutt through the heart. Tutt did the Funky Chicken for 20 yards and fell dead. Bill took back his watch. The photo is from Harper's New Monthly Magazine, February 1867. Wild Bill Hickok threatens the friend of Davis Tutt after defeating Tutt in a duel.

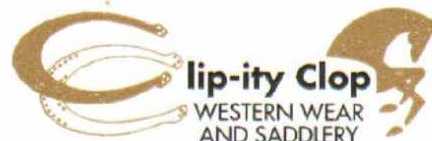
